

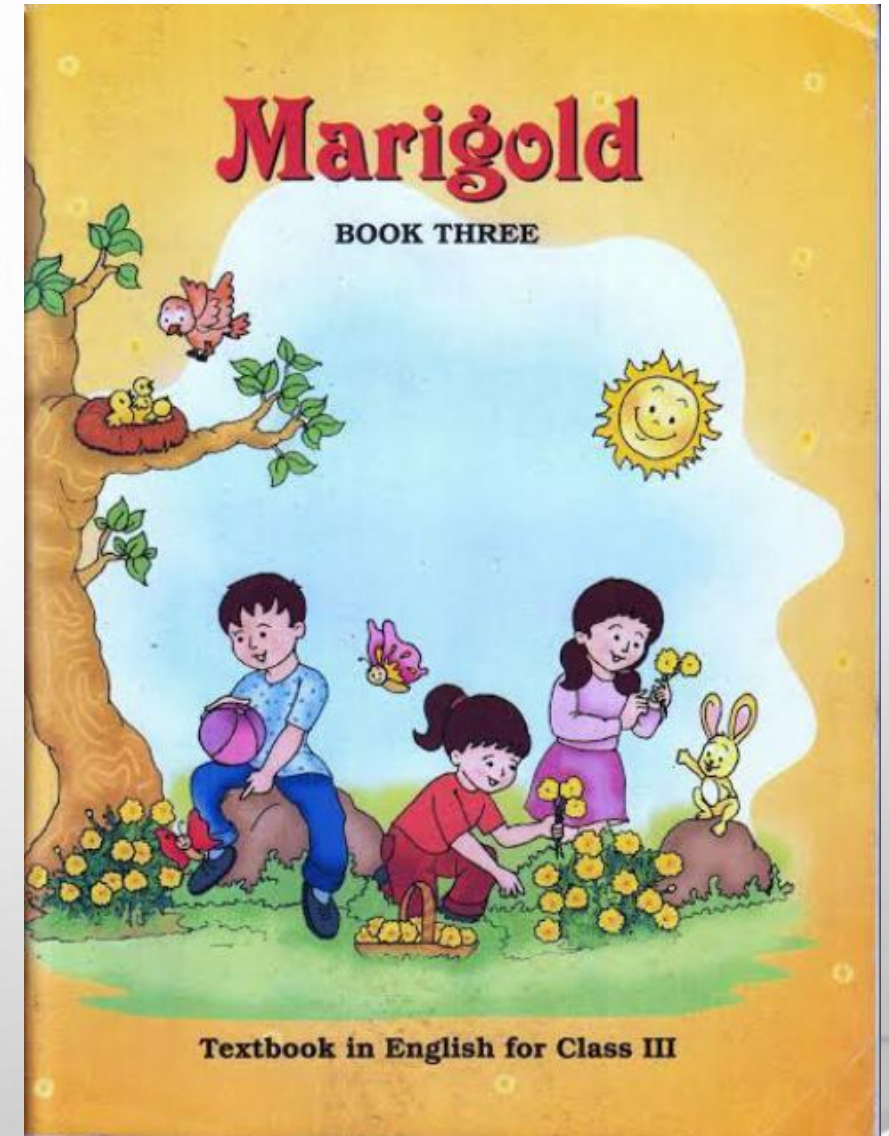




And creeping grass, and brownie bees!






How did you find out it was day?
